Test Lab Update

Capacity

18 of 24 machines are now in service (75%)

4 machines are undergoing commissioning tests

2 machines (BIOS issue blocked on DELL support)

Test loop backlog (pushgate) resolved

Loose Ends

Windows Licenses (have a way forward, waiting for concrete proposals)

Expected cost: \$100 per Windows VM per year

Contractor for web real estate maintenance

RESOLUTION: APM Hardware

“APM would like to donate two X-C1 EVK kits (total value \$5,200) to the Xen Project for continued development/support of XEN for ARM64.”

Test Framework WG agrees this is a good idea
(pending due diligence)

This will take away 2U's (of 5U's remaining in the existing rack)
May incur installation cost (not covered in original quote)
Thus: need AB agreement
